Three outstanding older Arkansans will be inducted into the Senior Arkansans Hall of Fame during the awards luncheon held in conjunction with the 29<sup>th</sup> Annual Arkansas Aging Conference, October 28 – 30, 2009 in Hot Springs.

Locate and click on “*Senior Arkansan Hall of Fame Nominations for 2009*”. On the next page, scroll down to find an on-line Nomination Form and instructions. Nominations must be submitted to the Area Agencies on Aging by no later than June 1, 2009.

To be considered for selection to the Senior Arkansans Hall of Fame, nominees shall:

- a) be citizens of the State of Arkansas,
- b) be at least 60 years old or older and living at the time of nomination,
- c) have performed outstanding volunteer contributions/services, which have promoted, enhanced and enriched the quality of life specifically for senior Arkansans, and
- d) have made significant and exemplary contributions to senior Arkansans.
