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## The Senior Arkansans Hall of Fame

The Senior Arkansans Hall of Fame was created by the 78th General Assembly to honor the significant contributions of older Arkansans. As stipulated in Act 1218 of 1991, the Senior Arkansans Hall of Fame is administered by the Division of Aging and Adult Services of the Department of Human Services. The selection process is conducted with assistance from the Arkansas Area Agencies on Aging. The final selection committee consists of representatives of the two Aging Legislative committees, the Arkansas Gerontological Society, and the Governor's Advisory Council on Aging.

### Nominating Procedures

***Nominations to the Senior Arkansans Hall of Fame for 2009 must be submitted no later than June 1, 2009 on an original or copy of the 2009 nomination form to the Executive Director of the Area Agency on Aging serving the region of the nominee's residence at the time of nomination.*** All requested information must be provided. Nominations containing more than six additional sheets will not be considered. Information in the Nomination Form will be verified by the Area Agency on Aging and forwarded to the Division of Aging and Adult Services. The Division forwards the nominations to the selection committee for scoring.

Three senior Arkansans will be selected for induction into the Senior Arkansans Hall of Fame for 2009. The induction ceremony will be Thursday, October 29, 2009 during the noon luncheon at the annual Arkansas Aging Conference held at the Hot Springs Convention Center.

### Criteria for Selection

To be considered for selection to the Senior Arkansans Hall of Fame, nominees shall:

- \* be a citizen of the State of Arkansas,
- \* be at least 60 years of age or older and living at the time of nomination, and
- \* have performed outstanding volunteer contributions or services, which have promoted, enhanced, and enriched the quality of life specifically for senior Arkansans, and made significant and exemplary contributions to Senior Arkansans.
