**These Guidelines relate to income eligibility for the following programs:**

- **ARSeniors: Equal to or Below 80%**
- **Qualified Medicare Beneficiary (QMB) = 100% Poverty / Resource Limit = \$4000 (I), \$**
- **Special Low Income Medicare Beneficiary (SLMB) = 120% Poverty / Resource Limit =**
- **Commodities Distribution Program = 130% Poverty / Resource Limit = None**
- **Weatherization programs = 125% Poverty / Resource Limit = None**
- **Qualified Individual #1 = 135% Poverty Resource Limits = \$4,000 (I), \$6,000 (C)**
- **Title V Older Worker Program = 125% Poverty Resources = None**
- **Working Disabled = 250% (For each additional family member in the Working Disabled \$750.00)**

**NOTE: State Older Worker Program limits are based on 200% SSI not on Poverty Guidelines.**
